

Lee Hunter founded Hunter Engineering in 1946 after returning from the war. His first invention, the Tune-In Wheel Balancer, was a revolution in the automotive service industry and a runaway success for the new company.

In the 1950s, Hunter expanded into wheel alignment, inventing the world's first simplified light beam aligner. In 1964, the company outgrew the small factory in the St. Louis suburbs and moved to the current 30-acre campus next to Lambert Airport.

In the ensuing decades, Hunter Engineering continued to lead the industry in innovation, pioneering the use of digital signal processing, computer graphics, and machine vision for wheel alignment and balancing. Today, Hunter Engineering leads the automotive service industry worldwide in wheel alignment, wheel balancing, tire mounting, and inspection technology.
