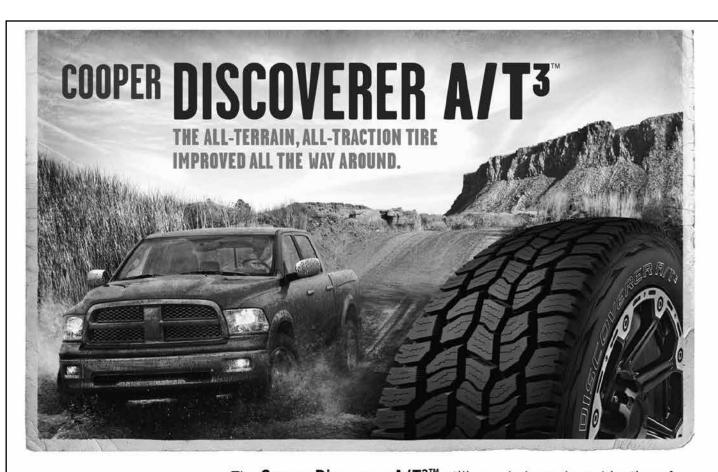

## PORTLAND TIRE DEALER FOUND DEAD

Frank Wilson, owner of Clackamas Tire & Brake, was found dead of a gunshot wound to the chest on September 24 after being missing for two days.

Police have released few details and first labeled the death "suspicious" and are asking the public to help solve a puzzling homicide at a roadside park on Mt. Hood.

Frank had worked in the Portland tire industry for over 30 years and was President of Chasco Inc., who operated Clackamas Tire & Brake, which he ran for 15 years.

## TIA ANNOUNCES 2015 HALL OF FAME & AWARDS RECEPIENTS

The Tire Industry (TIA) has announced the names of the 2015 Hall of Fame recipients. This year's honorees are Paul Hyatt, Chairman of Superior Tire & Auto and former President of TIA; Ross Fischer, the late owner of McCord Auto Supply; Herman "Hy" Freeman, Technical Services & Training Manager, Rema Tip Top North America (retired); Bucky Stein, Founder of Target Tire; and Dr. Raghupati Singhania, Chairman and Managing Director of JK Tyre & Industries Limited.

Paul Hyatt, known for his service on the TIA Board, began his career with Superior Tire & Auto when he was 17, working part-time sweeping floors and changing tires. By the age of 21, he was working as a teacher while continuing to work part-time at Superior. He became owner and president of the company in 1981.

TIA is also honoring Kevin Rohlwing, Senior Vice President of Training for the Tire Industry Association and Tom Klinge, Managing Director & Co-founder of the Klinge Group, with the distinguished Ed Wagner Leadership Award, named in honor of the late Ed Wagner whjo was a strong voice in the tire industry for the entirety of his career.

The Hall of Fame inductions and presentation of the Ed Wagner Leadership Awards will take place at the Tire Industry Honors Awards Ceremony on Monday, November 2, 2015, 6:00 p.m. – 7:30 p.m. at the Tropicana Las Vegas. The event, sponsored by Michelin North America, is open to all and complimentary tickets may be reserved on their web page tireindustry.org.

Pete Selleck, Chairman and President of Michelin North America, Inc., will be a special guest and give the keynote address at the Tire Industry Award Ceremony. Selleck is also the Charimon of the Board of the Rubber Manufacturers Association (RMA) and was recently recognized among 100 CEO leaders in STEM.

## NO MINIMUM WAGE INCREASE IN 2016

Washington State's minimum wage will remain \$9.47 an hour for next year. The reason is that consumer prices have been decreasing. Washington will no longer have the highest statewide minimum wage as of January 1.

This is only the second time that there has not been an increase since the state's voters approved the Minimum Wage a measure in 1998 that adjusted the minimum wage with inflation. The last time it did not increase was 2010.

A growing number of cities including Seattle, are looking at the costs and benefits of implementing citywide minimum wage laws. On April 1 of this year Seattle's new Minimum Wage Ordinance gave Seattle workers \$15 an hour, phased in over time.

Employers of more than 500 employees in the U.S. will pay each employee an hour minimum wage of at least:

- > \$11 by April 15, 2015
- > \$13. By January 1, 2016
- > \$15 by January 1, 2017

The Seattle ordinance does have different schedules for employers who have fewer than 500 employees and who offer minimum benefits and/or medical benefits.

#### **TIA OTR TRAINING**



Matt White of the Tire Industry Association will be the instructor of the NWTDA OTR/ETS training in Portland during the Tire Expo on February 4 & 5, 2016.

The TIA Basic Earthmover Tire Service (ETS) Training Program for OTR tire technicians is a 3 day training program that offers hands on training as well as classroom time. This training offers step-by-step procedures and safety guidelines for servicing one-piece, three-piece and five-piece wheels.

Matt will also be the instructor for a five day Advance ETS training. Details for the Advance class will be available by the end of November. Those interested can call the NWTDA office at 509-948-2433.

## CTS TRAINING AT NWTDA TIRE EXPO

The Northwest Tire Dealers Association will offer the Tire Industry Association's (TIA) Commercial Truck Service training seminar in Portland, Oregon during the association's Regional Meeting at the Holiday Inn at the airport on February 4, 2016.

The training will start at 7 a.m. and will cover 16 different modules. The training will run until 3 p.m. at which time the national certification test will be given. Details of the CTS training and other training programs during the Tire Expo will be mailed by December 1.

#### STUDDED SNOW TIRE SEASON

Studded snow tire season officially starts in Washington and Oregon on Sunday, November 1 and dealers in both states are stocking up on inventory and studding some of their inventory before the snow starts to fly.

Washington tire dealers should be aware that next year (July 1 of 2016) there will be a \$5 fee imposed on the retail sale of each new studded snow tire. Tire dealers will be responsible for collecting the fee, keeping 10% for handling and forwarding \$4.50 on to the Department of Revenue.

## RAYBESTOS BRAKE & CHASSIS TRAINING

Raybestos will offer a brake training seminar in Portland during the NWTDA Tire Expo on Thursday, February 4 at the Holiday Inn at the airport.

Technicians completing the brake module will be able to inspect the vehicle, analyze the brake components and perform the recommended repairs. They will be able to explain the relationship between the foundation brakes hydraulic system and the addition ABS stability control components. They will be able to explain the precautions necessary to perform hybrid vehicle brakes repair safely. They will also be able to identify the tire pressure monitoring system (TPMS) and explain how best to proceed with the repair and maintenance of the system. Technicians will be able to service ABS systems from the prospective of extended longevity and function.

Larry was born February 7, 1932 in Deadwood South Dakota and his family moved to Tillamook, Oregon in 1944. After graduation from Tillamook High School Larry served in the Army. When he returned from his military service in Germany he returned to Tillamook and went to work for Diamond Lumber.

Larry bought Tillamook Tire Service in 1964 and in 1976 built a retread plant. Larry had a real passion for the tire industry and served as a board member of the Northwest Tire Dealers Association for more than 20 years. He was a regular attendee at NWTDA trade shows and was known to travel to Louisville to the ARA (American Retread Association) meetings and shows.

Larry was a member of the Elks and the Eagles in Tillamook. He enjoyed many years of deer hunting with his friends.

Tillamook Tire Service continues with Larry's two sons, Gary and Larry and his three grandchildren, Lonny, Crystal and Lucas Wilson.
