For the past four years, Brian has been involved in the training and government affairs committees of TIA and hopes to continue his efforts in help update the TIA training modules with best practices.

Brian will be addressing Northwest tire dealers in a Thursday morning presentation of the Tire Industry Association's future plans for training and plans for the Global Tire Expo at the SEMA show in Las Vegas in November.

TPMS TRAINING AT THE NWTDA TIRE EXPO

Tom Smith of the CarQuest Technical Institute

Training will be the instructor for a "TPMS for Tire Technicians" class on Thursday afternoon September 9th during the NWTDA Tire Expo at the Holiday Inn on NE Columbia Blvd. in Portland, Oregon.

Tire pressure monitoring systems have been in use for over a decade and tire technicians often encounter TPMS issues when replacing/repairing, rotating, and/or balancing tires. This course covers these common issues, while also reviewing changes to tire pressure monitoring systems.

Including:

- New sensor technology
- Programmable sensors
- Aftermarket replacement sensors
- Tools necessary to service these systems

Tom will also be the instructor for the Friday afternoon class that takes a look at "TPMS Updates & Diagnostics"

As we mentioned, tire pressure monitoring systems have been around for a while and issues with these systems are now commonplace in the aftermarket repair shop. This course covers changes to tire pressure monitoring systems including: new sensor technology, programmable sensors, aftermarket replacement sensors and the tools necessary to service these systems.

ALIGNMENT CLASS OFFERED BY NWTDA

CarQuest Technical Institute Training will offer an alignment training class at the NWTDA Tire Expo in Portland on Thursday, September 9. Blake Cassidy will be the trainer for this 3 and a half hour class.

The primary goal of each wheel alignment service is to give our customers a safe and reliable vehicle that performs as designed every time. In this class a review of the alignment angles will be covered. This review is focused on what's important about angles and why we need to check them during every alignment. We will introduce a concept that will help balance the angles in the right relationship, ensuring performance that meets OE standards. The best practice alignment centers around the customer's expectations. The customer expects their vehicle to receive a complete alignment, and to be made aware of any underlying concerns that may need to be addressed to return their vehicle to proper alignment. The process that is covered in this class is very thorough and insures that the customer receives the technician's best efforts.

As a technician, this practice will be appreciated as it is designed to avoid as many comeback as possible. It begins with the pre-alignment preliminary inspection of the components, the vehicles driving tendencies and alignment angles. When these angles are not within the preferred specification, an adjustment or solution will be necessary. "Getting it in the green" or "setting the toe and letting it go" are not good enough, as we will discuss in this class.


THE PERFECT BRAKE JOB

CarQuest Technical Institute Training will offer a brake training class during NWTDA Tire Expo on Friday, September 10th at the Holiday Inn on NE Columbia Blvd. Blake Cassidy will be the instructor for this three and a half hour class starting at 8 am.

This class is designed to set standards of performance for every brake service professional. By following the guidelines in this class and workbook, you will know what is expected of you when performing a basic brake job. The primary goal of each brake job is to give your customers a safe and reliable vehicle that stops without noise every time. Keep these goals in mind as we review the Best Practices in Brake Service performance standards. Topics include best practices for brake inspection, friction selection, rotor machining using both on and off the car lathes, proper use of lateral runout measurements and rotor indexing and proper repair validation.

CarQuest will offer a second brake class Friday afternoon on Brake System Diagnostics. Blake Cassidy is the instructor for this three and a half hour class starting at 1 pm.

This class curriculum focuses on the brake system symptoms that are most commonly a concern of our customers and the proper diagnostic procedures performed by the professional technician during service.

GOODYEAR & COPPER HIKES CONSUMER TIRE PRICES

Goodyear Tire & Rubber Co. will increase consumer tire prices for the fourth time in less than a year. The next increase will go into effect on September 1.

Goodyear Chairman, CEO and President Rich Kramer told investors during the latest earnings call that consumer tire prices will increase up to 8% with this latest pricing action. The price increases will be on passenger and light truck tires from both Goodyear and the recentlyacquired Cooper Tire & Rubber Co.

LES SCHWAB TIRE CENTERS BUYS PLAINS TIRE CO. OF CASPER, WYO

Les Schwab Tire Centers has announced a deal to buy Plains Tire Co., a tire dealership owned by the Nicholls family with nine stores in Wyoming.

The deal is expected to close in August, a Les Schwab Tire spokesman said, noting that it is pursuing other expansion and buy-out opportunities alongside new store construction to build its network.

Les Schwab opened its first store in Wyoming in Rock Springs – a community of about 23,000 near the Colorado-Utah state lines – in 2019 with plans to grow its footprint over time.

"With this purchase, we are able to serve much of the state in one step," Les Schwab CEO Jack Cuniff said. "Plains Tire is a strong and healthy company, and it's exciting to be able to speed up our growth by welcoming these stores, employees and customers into Les Schwab."

Plains Tire's stores are located in Casper (2 stores), Evanston, Gillette, Green River, Laramie, Riverton, Rock Springs and Sheridan.

TIA TO CELEBRATE ITS 100 YEARS OF SERVICE TO THE INDUSTRY



President Biden recently issued an executive order addressing right to repair concerns and repair barriers. Biden signed the order as part of a plan to boost competition across numerous sectors, from healthcare to the auto industry, online platforms, and consumer devices. The order also aims for better regulatory support for independent automotive repair shops.

Right to repair remains a top priority for the Tire Industry Association (TIA) as well as many other automotive associations. TIA has been working with other industry groups and the FTC on this initiative.

TIA thanks the administration for recognizing the importance of right to repair to ensure consumers have access to the repair shop of their choice.

The executive order is aimed at promoting competition in the United States and is sure to give a boost to the right to repair movement.


